- Ms Hillson our new Inclusion Partner for settling into The Hive and getting to know us.

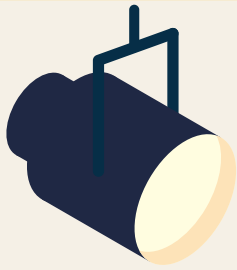

ATTENDANCE SPOTLIGHT

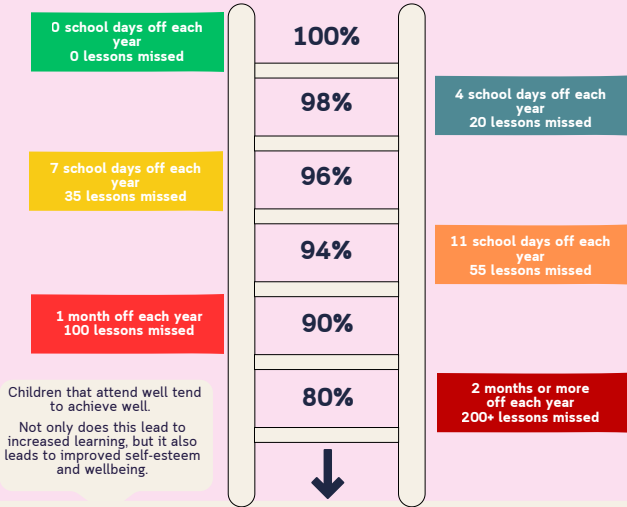


Absence from School

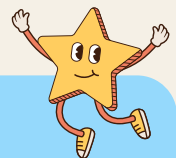


SEND SPOTLIGHT
