- Arthur - for settling into your new classroom exceptionally well in the new KS2 building. We are super proud of you!

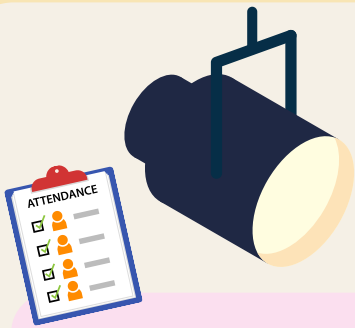

ATTENDANCE SPOTLIGHT



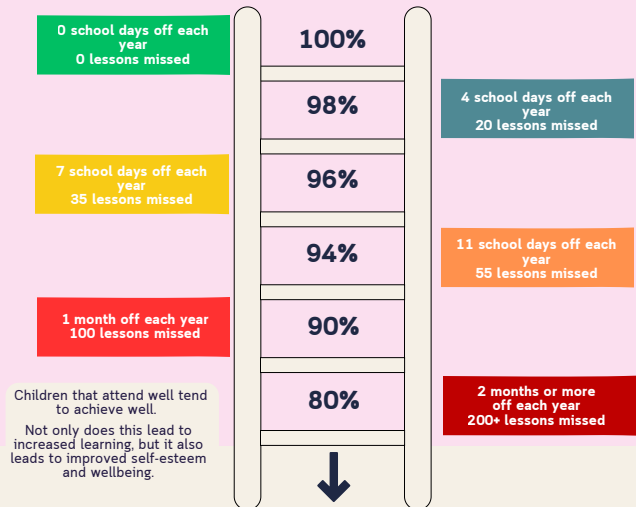
Absence from School
