- Ms Smart - for going above and beyond and for taking such good care of our site.



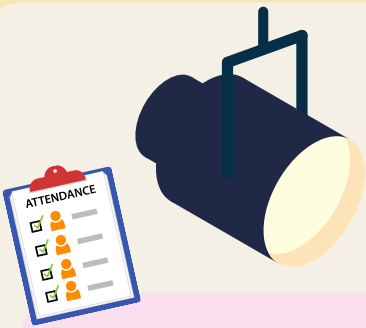

ATTENDANCE SPOTLIGHT



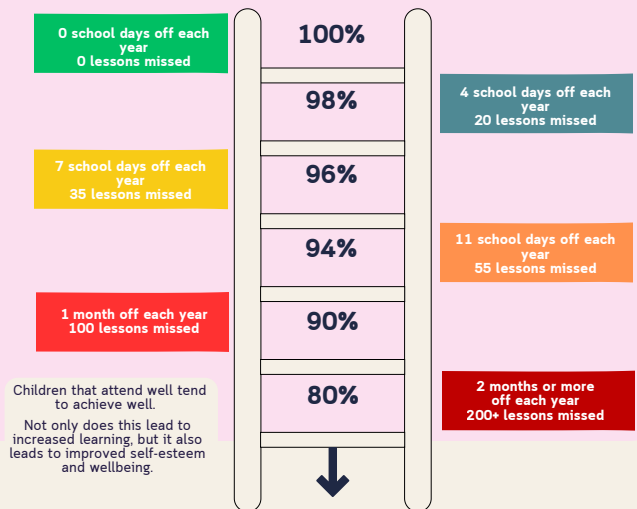
Absence from School

- Absence should only occur when your child is far too ill to attend.
- If your child is suffering from **Colds, Headaches, Tiredness** or **Sore throat** we would suggest that you administer paracetamol or ibuprofen and bring them into school, if their condition deteriorates, we will always call you.
- Family holidays and day trips must be arranged outside of school hours.
- Medical or dental appointments should be arranged outside of school hours, if this is not possible supporting evidence should be provided.

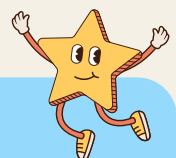
SEND SPOTLIGHT

Did you know you can use the NHS Right to Choose pathway to request an autism or ADHD assessment for your child?

If your GP agrees an assessment is appropriate, you have the legal right to ask for a referral to an NHS-approved provider of your choice, rather than joining the local waiting list. This can sometimes mean a quicker assessment, and the diagnosis is recognised by the NHS and schools. To use this route, you must be registered with a GP in England and choose a provider who has an NHS contract for children's assessments. Not all providers offer follow-up care or medication, so check carefully before deciding. If you'd like to use Right to Choose, research suitable providers, then ask your GP to make the referral directly. More information is available at www.nhs.uk
