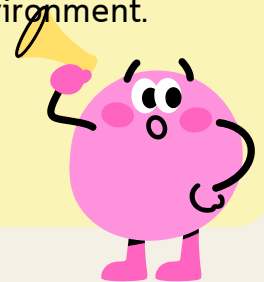

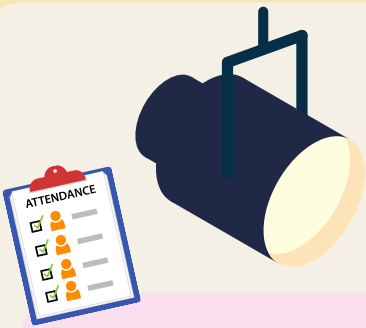

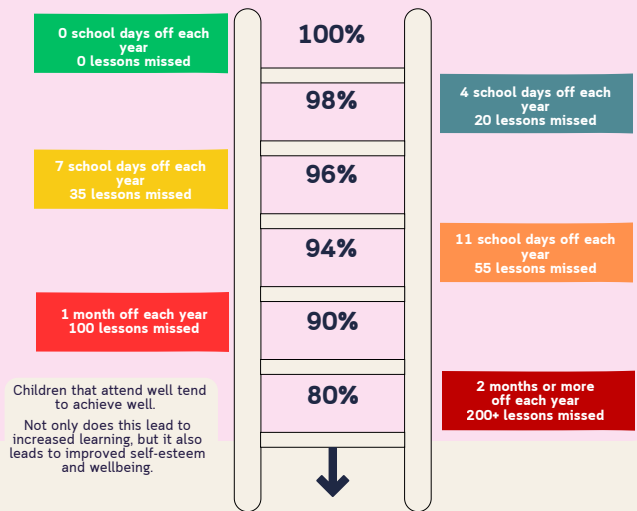
Absence from School
