- Year 6 children for their focus completing their mock SATs this week.



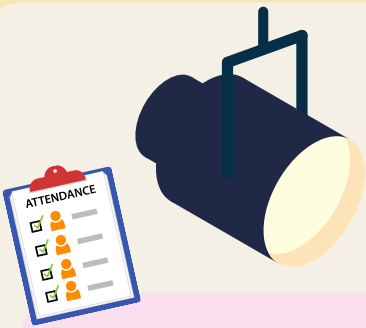

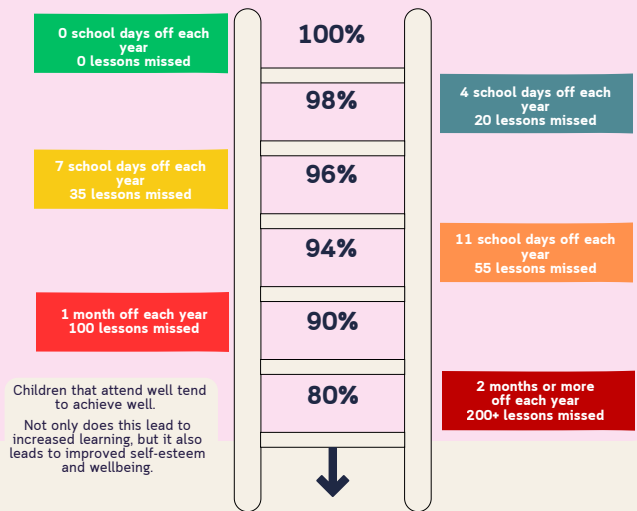
Absence from School
