- We are so proud of Charlie for becoming the Under 8s World Champion in Kick Pad Sumo!

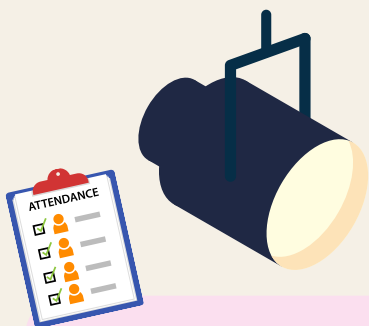

CHARACTER SPOTLIGHT

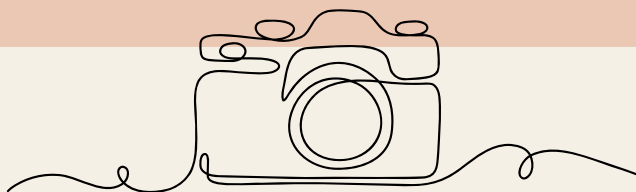


It was great to see pupils meet as whole societies today! They explored different activities and have been set a class challenge to complete and feed back to their society.
