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CLASS UPDATES



RECEPTION

Reception had their first school trip last week and they were utterly AMAZING.

Well done Reception on being so wonderfully safe and well behaved on your first trip. All things summer, animals, growing and recycling has been Reception's main focus so far this term. They have reused plastic bottles to make an 'odd fish' just like their story, they have been monitoring the changes in their brand new class caterpillars and they have even been tasting new fruits that we enjoy in the summertime! In maths they have been recapping all things numbers: odds and evens, doubles.



This week has been another busy and fun filled week of learning in Year 1! The children have been innovating part of the class text 'The Way Back Home'. They have been very creative with their choice of vehicle as well as using fantastic adjectives to describe them. In Maths they have started looking at position and direction and using this language to give directions to each other. In their theme lessons they have continued to learn about the United Kingdom, countries and capital cities. Keep up the hard work Year 1, I couldn't be prouder!

YEAR 2

What a busy week of amazing learning for Year 2! They had lots of outside learning experiences where they practised their sketching techniques whilst making close observations of nature. In Maths, they have worked really hard to master multiplication, division and time.

Also, they started their week by going on a trip to the library. This included lots of fun activities in different workshops and they also got to take some awesome books home with their new library cards! YEAR 4

Year 4 have had a busy week of learning. In maths they have been looking at different types of charts, answering problem solving and reasoning questions. They have been practising ready for sports day, using teamwork, resilience and perseverance. In English, they have been exploring Roman villas and using various language features in their writing. Attendance Ladder

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


