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CLASS UPDATES

RECEPTION

Reception children have blown us away! This week was their first full week in school and they have exceeded all expectations! They have started phonics lessons daily and are already enjoying learning their new sounds. In maths they have been focusing on all things numbers 1, 2 and 3 and matching items based on colours and patterns.

YEAR 1

Year 1 has had a fantastic few weeks! They have used charcoal, felt-tip pens and crayons to experiment with making lines and dots in the style of Paul Klee. They have also used their imaginations to change a character from the story 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears'. There were many creative designs, including a cheetah and dinosaur!

YEAR 2

It has been a busy week in year 2. Year 2 have demonstrated their love of experiments as they tested materials to find the most absorbent and materials that are waterproof. They have started to write their innovated story of Little Red and I am very proud of the grammar skills they have remembered from Year 1. Keep up the great work Year 2!



YEAR 3

What a wonderful fortnight for year 3! They have now completed their first residential as well. It was a great success and showing wonderful team building and resilience. They have also taken part in an immersive forest school to help them start to think like they're from the Stone Age

YEAR 4

Year 4 has shown resilience and independence over the last few weeks! They have had a busy few weeks writing about Mount Vesuvius and have now started to plan a Non-Chronological report on Ancient Rome. They had a fantastic trip to the Roman Museum and made themselves and Tyndale proud. Year 4 have now finished their place value unit in Maths and are moving on to addition and subtraction of 4 digit numbers. They have been doing some great learning - keep up the good learning!

YEAR 5

Year 5 have been very busy and have now finished their first writing, and maths unit. They are now place value experts and all wrote fantastic informal letters about a school trip to Egypt. Keep up the fantastic work Year 5!

YEAR 6

Year 6 have been working hard in English by practising their writing skill, this week they have been writing biographies. Implementing new and old skills such as writing in third person and using 'passive voice' in sentences. 


