The following uniform expectations apply to all students:

Jumper and Tie				
	School Jumper	Navy with School Logo Compulsory item. Must be worn every day.		
	School Tie (Years 1-6 Children Only)	School Tie with Logo Compulsory item. Must be worn every day.		
Shirts, Blouses and Polo Tops				
	Shirt or Blouse (Years 1-6 Children Only)	White Shirt or Blouse (short or long sleeved) Compulsory item. Must be worn every day. Shirts/Blouse should be tucked in at all times and suitable for wearing with a tie		
	School Polo Top (EYFS - Reception Children Only)	White Polo Top with School Logo Compulsory item for Reception children. Must be worn every day.		





Trousers, Shorts or Skirt			
	Grey Trousers or Shorts	Tailored Grey Trousers or Shorts Full length to the ankle. No 'skinny' trousers or leggings will be accepted. No sweatshirt fabric, chino or jean style or sports shorts will be acceptable. Tailored shorts must be knee length.

	Tartan Skirt	School Tartan Skirt Elasticated in EYFS, Year 1 and Year 2 Wrap around in Years 3-6 Not excessively short, not below mid-calf.	
Shoes and Socks or Tights			
	Shoes	Plain black, low heels and low soles, leather or similar material No canvas or trainer style shoes will be accepted.

1	Tights	Plain black opaque	







Jewellery:

The only jewellery which is acceptable is a wrist watch and one pair of small plain gold or silver stud earrings. Any other form of jewellery is not allowed.

Hair:

No extreme hairstyle or dyed hair will be permitted, including dip-dyed and unnatural hair colours. This includes tramlines, mohican or skinhead-type styles. All children with long hair must tie it back for PE lessons. Pupils may wear hair accessories if they are subtle and are red or navy. Multi-coloured, large hair accessories such as animal ear style headbands are not permitted.
